So what of the future? Mike Park is in no doubt and says: "While we've continued to grow and have established a good reputation among landlords for looking after the water we rent, so far we have been unable to achieve our greatest ambition—to have permanent access to a lake in or near Dorchester.

"The demand for angling facilities for coarse fishermen in Dorchester is high, but the availability on our doorstep is virtually nil.
